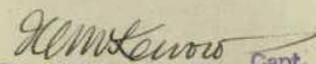

I was cutting timber in Far North Queensland at a place called ~~Herberton~~ outside Herberton. I used to keep my personal papers in a wooden box under the bed in my camp. One day I came home and looked in the box, only to find all my papers all eaten up by White Ants. Amongst those papers was an Entitlement for Medical Treatment for Bi-Lateral Plantar Callosities as being due to War Service. In the left hand top corner there was a numeral starting with R.X. I forget the 4 figures that followed. I would like to know whether I could get another paper setting out my disability as it is playing up with me now and I would like to get treatment for it. I last had treatment at Concord Military Hospital Sydney either in 1951 or 1952, and my Medical History went onto Repat Department in Grace Buildings Sydney, that's as far as I know.
Though slightly tattered I was able to

salvage my discharge paper as it was in a
seperate tin. Will I forward that to you, it may
help. My Rank was Sapper. My Army Number
was. VX60836

I would also like to apply for my War Medals
I was in Timor and New Guinea in the
2/2 Commando Company I went to Timor about the
8th of December 1941 and came back at about
December the 12th 1942.

I'm not too sure when I left for New Guinea
and when I returned, but I think I left Australia
